Overview

Kenowa Hills Public Schools is committed to ensuring the health and safety of our students, staff, community members, and guests. All groups who enter District facilities will be required to follow all of the safety protocols as described below as well as other protocols and regulations that may be issued by a District staff member at any time if needed to promote health and safety. We are excited to welcome your and your dancer our facility and are looking forward to a fun weekend of dance!

General Protocols

- Masks that cover the mouth and nose must be worn by all persons, over the age of 3, at all times while on school property. Violators will be escorted from the premises.
- Physical distancing of 6' from members of other households must be practiced whenever possible.
- Eating and drinking will not be permitted inside the building. Quick drinks from water bottles are permitted throughout the facility as long as physical distance is maintained.

Arrival

- Your studio has been assigned a parking lot to help ease congestion in the parking area.
- All vehicles must park in marked parking spots. RV's and campers are allowed but must be park in marked spaces.
- A maximum of 1 guardian per dancer will be allowed into the building. In order to comply with venue capacity limits, no additional audience members will be permitted inside the building.
- Your studio has been assigned a building entry time. Please wait in the parking lot until your entry time.

Entry

- In order to enter the building, you and your dancer must have in hand a signed Waiver and Health Screening Form
 provided by Kenowa Hills Public Schools. This document should be provided to you by your studio. Extra forms will
 be available at the door.
 - Please note, if your dancer will be traveling with someone other than you, your dancer must bring a waiver that has been signed by you.
 - A temperature check and additional health screening may be performed when you enter.
- A color coded wristband will be issued to you and your dancer once you have turned in signed waivers and have
 passed the health screening.
 - Wristbands must be worn and be visible at all times while inside the building, including while performing. Anyone without a visible wristband will be escorted from the building.
 - You may check out, return your wrist band, and exit the building at any time to allow your dancer's other parent/guardian to check in and watch your dancer perform, if desired.
- You and your dancer may be checked in and issued wrist bands up to 20 minutes early so that you are ready to enter the building at your scheduled entry time. After being checked in, please return to the parking lot until your entry time.
- You and your dancer will be directed to the dressing rooms and backstage area after entering the building as the theater seating area will be undergoing cleaning at this time. Once the theater is clean, you will be free to move about the building during competition.

Dressing Rooms

• Your dancer should arrive in their 1st costume with their makeup applied and hair styled. Dressing rooms may be used only for changing and storing costumes. Masks may not be removed for makeup application. A limited number of hanging racks will be provided to hang costumes.

Exit Protocols

- All items must be removed from dressing rooms prior to the start of the awards ceremony so that these areas can be cleaned and the next studio can enter.
- You and your dancer will be allowed to exit and re-enter the building as needed during your studio's competition time as long as you have your wristband on.
- Everyone must exit the building through the designated doors immediately after the awards ceremony to allow the next studio to prepare for their performances.
